

Monday Intermediate Ladies League

- League play is stroke play with two-person teams.
- June 8 - Season starts (First Half Series)
- July 13 – First ½ Series Final Night
- July 20 – Second ½ Series Start
- August 24 – Second ½ Series Final Night
- August 31 – Championship Night for 1st – 4th place. Rest of team play 2-person net scramble for prizes. 4:40pm Shotgun Start for all (Dinner & Banquet)
- Finals - pairing the first & second half weeks 1st place teams vying for overall 1st & 2nd place.
- Semifinals - pairing the first & second half 2nd place teams vying for overall 3rd & 4th place.
- In the case of a team finishing in the same position in both halves, the next place team will represent the next place. (i.e. - winners of 1st place in half one cannot vie for the Final or Semifinals in half two)
- League payouts will be based on the semi-final & final match's on 8/31/20.
- CDGA or certified & verifiable USGA online handicaps are preferred for all league members.
- Players without Handicaps are eligible & will receive a handicap after week 1.
- Substitutes are not required; one player can represent the team in a weekly match vs. the opposing teams.
Substitutes are allowed and if they do not have a handicap, they will receive one after the round.
- League members are prohibited from substituting for another team.

- **Weekly Green Fees apply in addition to league entry. \$23 walk - \$33 ride**

Point Allocation

- **Points will be awarded weekly as follows.**
- **10 total points per Team match are available weekly.**
- **2 points for each Individual Net Single Match (low handicap plays low handicap for up to 4 points per team. Players are scored per hole. Halved Single Matches result in 1 point per individual.**
- **4 points for the low Net team score. (You get this by taking the total gross score of both team players and subtract their handicaps) Halved Team Matches result in 2 points per team.**
- **1 point for each players participation nightly**
- **If an entire team no shows, the opposing team gets a Full 10 points, if only 1 player plays then the match is for 9 points as 1 participation point is not awarded.**

Dues

- **All members shall pay annual dues of \$85 per player plus weekly green / cart fees.**
- **Dues cover admin, prizes and fees for the end of the year banquet.**
- **Dues are non-refundable and must be paid before a player competes in the league.**
- **Banquet Fees are non-refundable if you choose not to attend.**

Events

- **Events are played on Monday Evenings.**
- **Teams may elect to pre-play a league match if both teams agree.**
- **Pre-played matches must be completed *prior* to the schedule day and time.**
- **No matches may be played after the scheduled time and day.**

Tee Times

- Tee times are all at **4:40 pm** on Monday evenings.
- You will be supplied with a schedule and players information list.
- Matches must start prior to **4:40 pm** unless otherwise agreed to or the match will be considered forfeit.

Rain Outs / Unplayable Conditions

- If inclement weather effects the completion of a Regular Event, rain checks on golf and cart will be issued for weekly paid starts.
- Once the ThorGuard Lightening Alarm has sounded ALL PLAY shall be suspended until an all clear Alarm or decision to continue to play is announced.

Handicaps / Scoring

- Each Group competing must return a scorecard, co-signed by at least one team member in each group after completion of play. (The FORE Bar deck will have a scorecard receptacle)
- Each team will receive a scorecard. Only one scorecard needs to be verified and submitted after the round. This will allow each player to readily be aware of how many strokes per hole they are allowed when calculating maximum strokes per hole and net score. Gross scores should be written down on scorecard for each hole.
 - Maximum gross score (or strokes per hole) is Double Par plus Handicap Stroke(s) provided on hole played (noted by dots on scorecard for each hole). Example for player getting 2 strokes (two dots) on a hole: On a Par 5 Player A can pick up following

their 11th stroke if not holed. Gross score will be 12 (max) Net score will be 10.

Example for player getting 1 stroke on a hole: On a Par 4 Player B can pick up following

their 8th stroke if not holed. Gross score will be 9 (max) Net score will be 8. Example

for player getting 2 strokes on a hole: On a Par 3 Player C can pick up following their

7th stroke if not holed. Gross score will be 8 (max) Net score will be 6. ALL PLAYERS

MUST EITHER HOLE OUT OR ACCEPT MAX GROSS SCORE FOR TEAM SCORING

Rules of Play

- U.S.G.A. Rules Govern all play except when determined by committee.
(Winter Rules All Season)
- The 14-club rule is always in effect
- Players MUST leave the flagstick in the hole while putting.
- Players may repair spike marks or other damage, including footprints, on the green with no penalty.
- You can lift, clean & place in the sand trap. You cannot ground your club in the sand trap on a practice swing.
- Loose stones and debris in a bunker may be removed without penalty.
- 3 Minute Time-limit when searching for a lost ball.
- Ladies play from the Bronze Tee markers.
- Putts that are within (1) putter-head length of the hole (Approximately 4 inches) are deemed “Good” and shall count as one stroke and a completed hole. Opponents have conceded the putt & state: “That putt is Good”
- There would be no penalty for a player accidentally moving a ball on the putting surface
- It is permitted to give advice to anyone in your foursome.

- It is permitted to accept or ask for advice in your foursome.
- Free relief from French tile drains and any exposed drainage.
- ALL Hazards and out of bounds should be played as a Water or Lateral Hazard. Players incur a one stroke penalty and have two options of how to play the ball. They are: 1. From the spot where your ball crossed into the hazard, drop outside the lateral water or out of bounds within two club-lengths of that spot: or 2. Drop on the opposite side of the hazard at a point equidistant to the hole. No closer to the hole in either case.
- Every stroke must be counted including when you miss the ball. If you swing at the ball with the intent to hit the ball and miss, you must count that stroke.

Obstructions

- Cart paths are immovable obstructions. Nearest relief with stance and one club length may be taken no nearer the hole for your drop.

Slow Play

- Please remember to keep your entire group moving by looking for and watching each other's golf balls.
- Please Keep pace with the group in front of you.
- Start to plan your next shot before you get to your ball. Be prepared to hit when it is your turn.
- When on the green, mark your ball if you are in the putting line of another golfer. You do not have to mark your golf ball on the green.

Deerfield Golf Club Rules & Procedures for Phase 3

We are asking that all on-site guests wear masks covering their mouth and nose when heading to their starting tee. There will be no congregating at either tee 1 or 10 so please don't leave your car area until about 10 minutes before your tee-time unless you want to wait to putt and see an open hole or are willing to wait for a spot. See below for range use. Due to the limited capacity of our deck & dining seating, all patrons seated or standing at our new outdoor BARS, yes I said BARS, must remain 6-ft from each other & must order an entrée or small plate per guest to secure their seat / space. All guests dining on the deck are required to wear a face mask covering their mouth and nose until they are in a designated open seat or spot. (Tables & seats are marked 6ft from others & must remain in these spots) Once in your spot / seat masks are not required while eating and drinking. (If using the restroom or picking up a to-go drink at the desk bar masks are required while moving around the deck) TBE if we may start taking reservations. Special Note – Due to the limited amount of golf cars on hand and the single rider rule in place ALL GOLF CARTS MUST BE RETURNED PROMPTLY FOLLOWING YOUR FINAL HOLE OF PLAY.

Practice facilities are open at a 50% capacity (driving range & putting greens) – The use of the range is by pre-payment only which can be booked directly on our website. NO IN-PERSON SALES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ONLINE. deerfieldgolf.org then go to learning center then click on practice facilities to book your range time.

Restaurant & Food Beverage The FORE restaurant will be open for sit-down dining on a first come first serve basis. A limited take-out only menu will be available on our mobile app. Search deerfieldgolf – IL for the mobile app. All take-out orders will be prepaid and delivered to you near the south putting green. This is the waiting zone. The deck is only available for tableside or bar seating. The halfway house will open Friday afternoons and Saturday and Sundays from 8:30am until 4pm. (Subject to change) Beer, Bloody's and more available at the Halfway House. The pro shop window located at the top of the west deck stairwell can be accessed for snacks and drinks. (just knock on the window, by the sign for soft drinks, beer, water, Gatorade and a limited selection of candy, chips, and snacks)

All on-sight payments are credit card only. No Cash Payments will be Accepted. The pro shop will be open for retail sales only. (Attire, shoes, clubs, and accessories for purchase only) – There is maximum of 2 guests in the pro-shop at a time. Enter from the back of the pro-shop (south doors) and you can only exit to the north.

The driving range restrooms are the only clubhouse area restrooms for use. On-course restrooms remain open

Player Restrictions Any player with any symptoms of COVID-19, should not play, nor should they if someone in their household has symptoms of COVID-19. All players and guests should practice social distancing on tees, greens, and throughout our property for the day while visiting. Golfers should pick up his/her own ball, handle your own scorecard and never touch a flagstick while playing. Golfers should arrive to their starting hole No Earlier than 10 minutes prior to their tee-time. Unless you find a putting spot or reserve a range bay we are asking to remain near your car until the start of play. No handshakes at the beginning of the round or at the 18th hole Thanks for reading, the Deerfield Golf Club Team looks forward to hosting you!
